Mujer Klórica is founded on two main ideas: the recovery of Andalusian flamenco and folklore emphasizing its validity and reclaiming the role of woman in the past, present and into the future.

The structures used in this Flamenco work cover socio-cultural issues, growing to create a close link with the figure of women in words, music and aesthetics. These are the starting points for these artists to seek equality for people regardless of their social status, gender, religion and origin.
